

WORD LIST, ABBREVIATIONS, & COMMON ACRONYMS

In general we follow the UW's list of common words and terms. Here are SPH-specific words and common acronyms:

Adviser

- Not advisor

Alum, alumna, alumnus, alumni

- Alum = use as a singular, gender-neutral term
- Alumna = use in reference to a woman (alumnae is the plural form)
- Alumnus = use in reference to a man (alumni is the plural form)
- Alumni = use in reference to a group of men and women

Academic quarters

- Always lowercase
- Use autumn not fall

a.m., p.m.

- Include a space between the number and the a.m. or p.m. and write out in lowercase and with periods

ASPPH

- Academic Schools and Programs of Public Health

Biostat

- Department of Biostatistics

Campuswide

- One word and not hyphenated

CDC

- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention

COPHP

- Community-Oriented Public Health Practice

COVID-19

- Use COVID-19 not coronavirus, covid or SARS-CoV-2
- If it must be spelled out, use coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

DEOHS

- Department of Environmental & Occupational Health Sciences
- Use an ampersand instead of the word “and”

DGH

- Department of Global Health

EDI

- Equity, Diversity and Inclusion
- Always in this order EDI; not DEI

Health care

- Two words

HIHIM

- Health Informatics and Health Information Management (undergraduate program)

HPRC

- Health Promotion Research Center

HServ

- Department of Health Services (former name of HSPop)

HSPop

- Health Systems and Population Health
- Spell out the word “and” do not use an ampersand

IPHG

- Institute for Public Health Genetics

I-TECH

- International Training and Education Center for Health

Legislature

- Lowercase when used generically
- Capitalize when it follows the name of a state or in specific references

MCH

- Maternal and Child Health

MHA

- Master of Health Administration

MHIHIM

- Master's of Health Informatics and Health Information Management

NIH

- National Institutes of Health

NSP

- Nutritional Sciences Program

NWCPHP

- Northwest Center for Public Health Practice

OD

- Office of the Dean
- Use Office of the Dean not Dean's Office

Online Master of Public Health Program

- Spell out full name of program on first reference, abbreviate to Online MPH Program thereafter
- Program is capitalized because it is part of the official name

MHA

- Master of Health Administration

Policymaker

- One word

PH-GH

- Public Health-Global Health major

PHSKC

- Public Health – Seattle & King County
- Use en dash with one space before and after the dash
- Use an ampersand instead of spelling out "and"

Preventive

- Not preventative

Seattle Children's

- This is the official name

SPH or the School

- Refers to the UW School of Public Health
- Always spell out “the School of Public Health” on first reference then abbreviate to “the School” or “SPH”
- In noun form use “the School” when abbreviating
- In adjective form use “SPH” when abbreviating
- Always mention the School of Public Health up high in the copy and associate with the University of Washington
- **In department news acknowledge the School of Public Health**

SPH Awards of Excellence

- Not SPH Excellence Awards

UW

- University of Washington
- Spell out “the University of Washington” on first reference, then abbreviate thereafter
- Include “the” in noun form (ex. Students at the UW have a lot of studying to do)
- Omit “the” in adjective form (ex. UW students want to be in the classroom)

WSPHA

- Washington State Public Health Association

Well-being

- hyphenate
