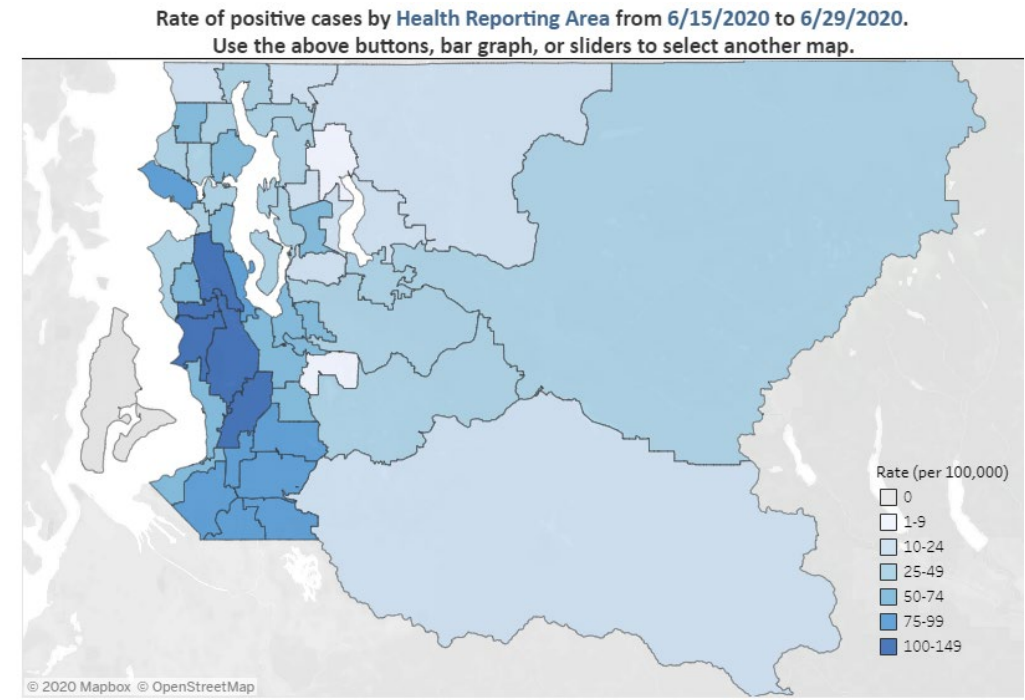
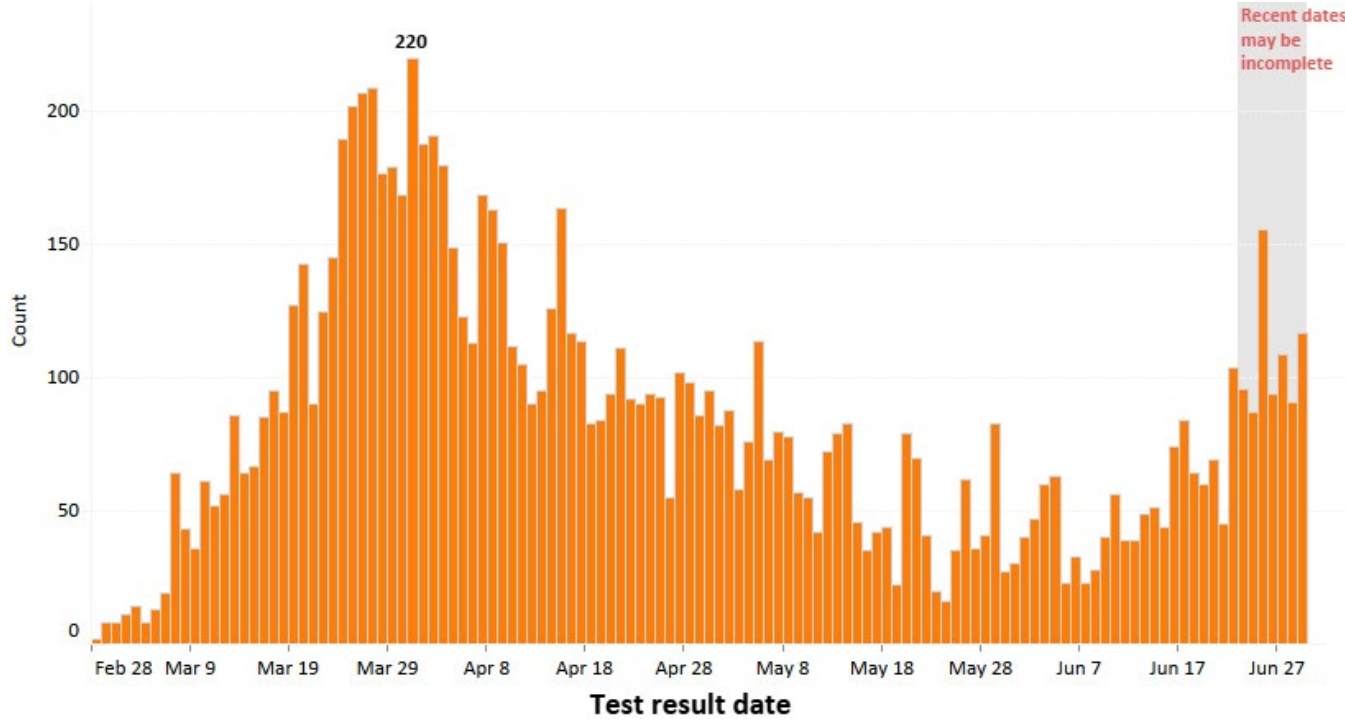

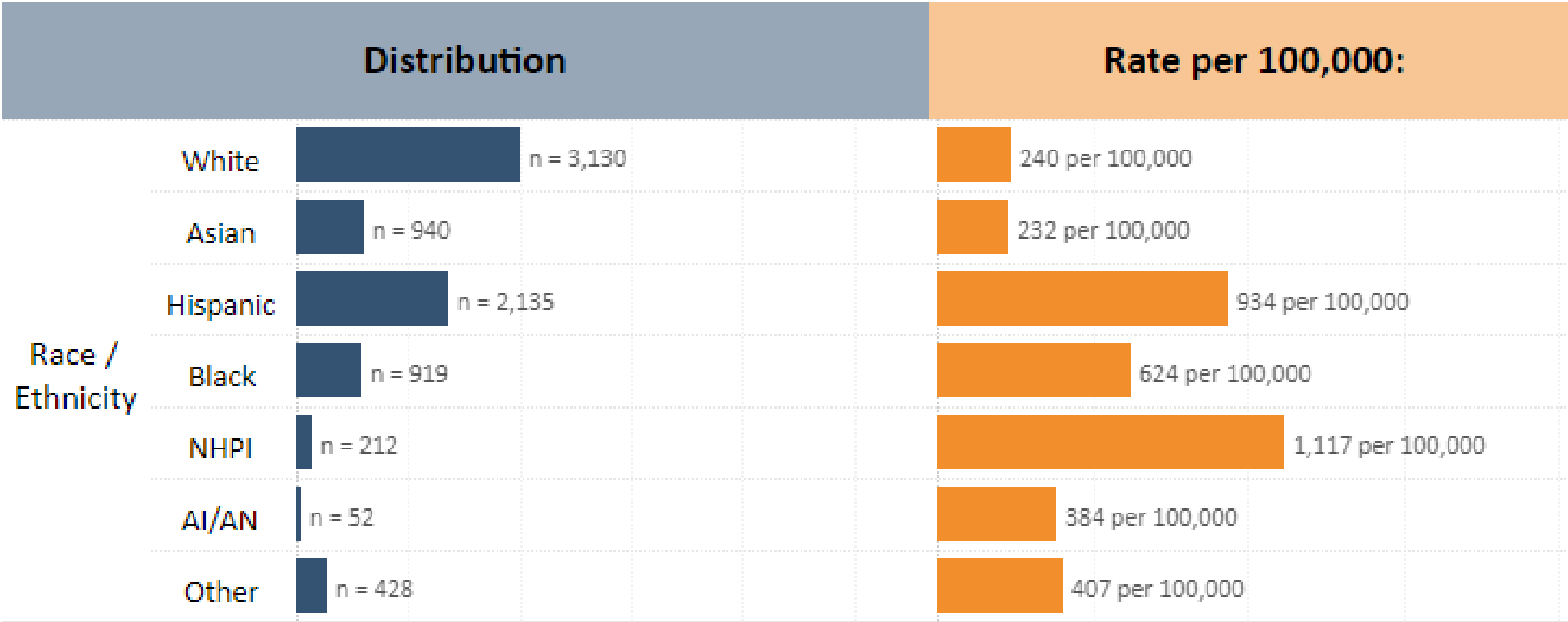
PHSKC COVID-19 Outbreak Summary Counts

- **10,328 confirmed cases**
 - 6.1% of all persons tested
- **588 deaths due to COVID-19 illness**
 - 5.7% of cases
- **168,858 King County residents tested**
 - 1 in 13 residents tested at least once
- **1,589 hospitalizations**
 - 15.4% of cases

PHSKC COVID-19 Outbreak Race/Ethnicity Distribution & Rate

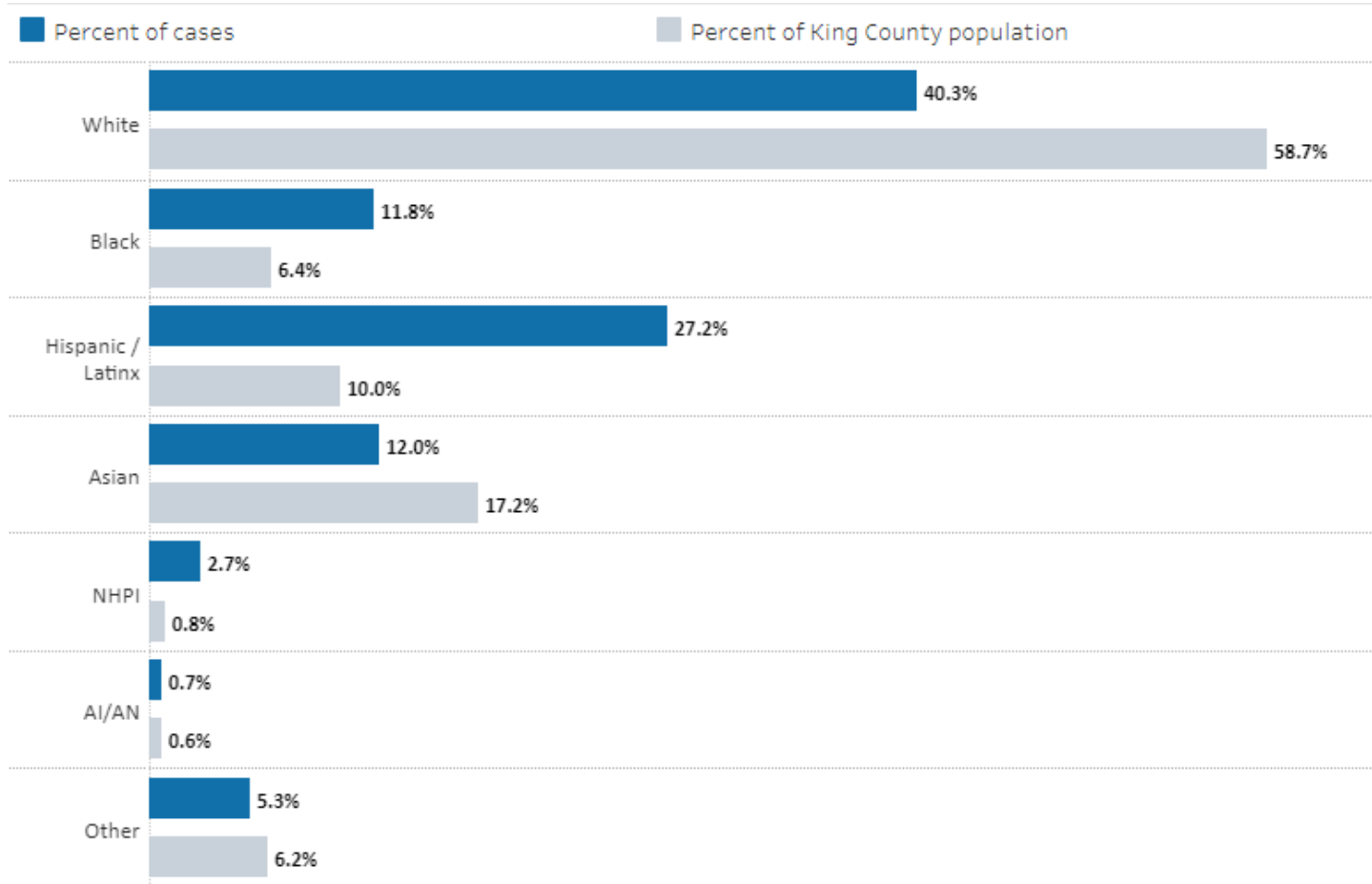

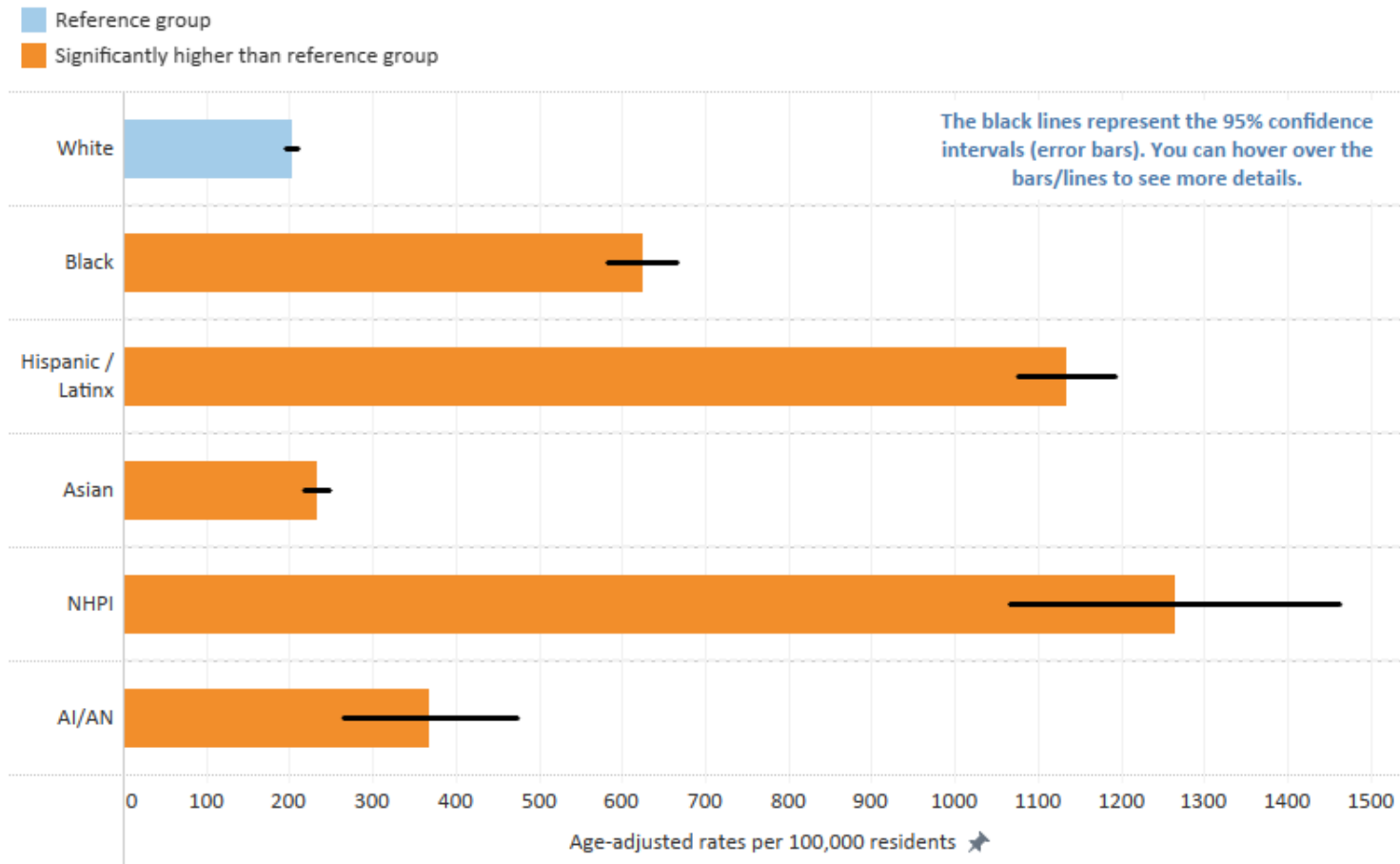

Rates are age-adjusted using the King County 2019 population.

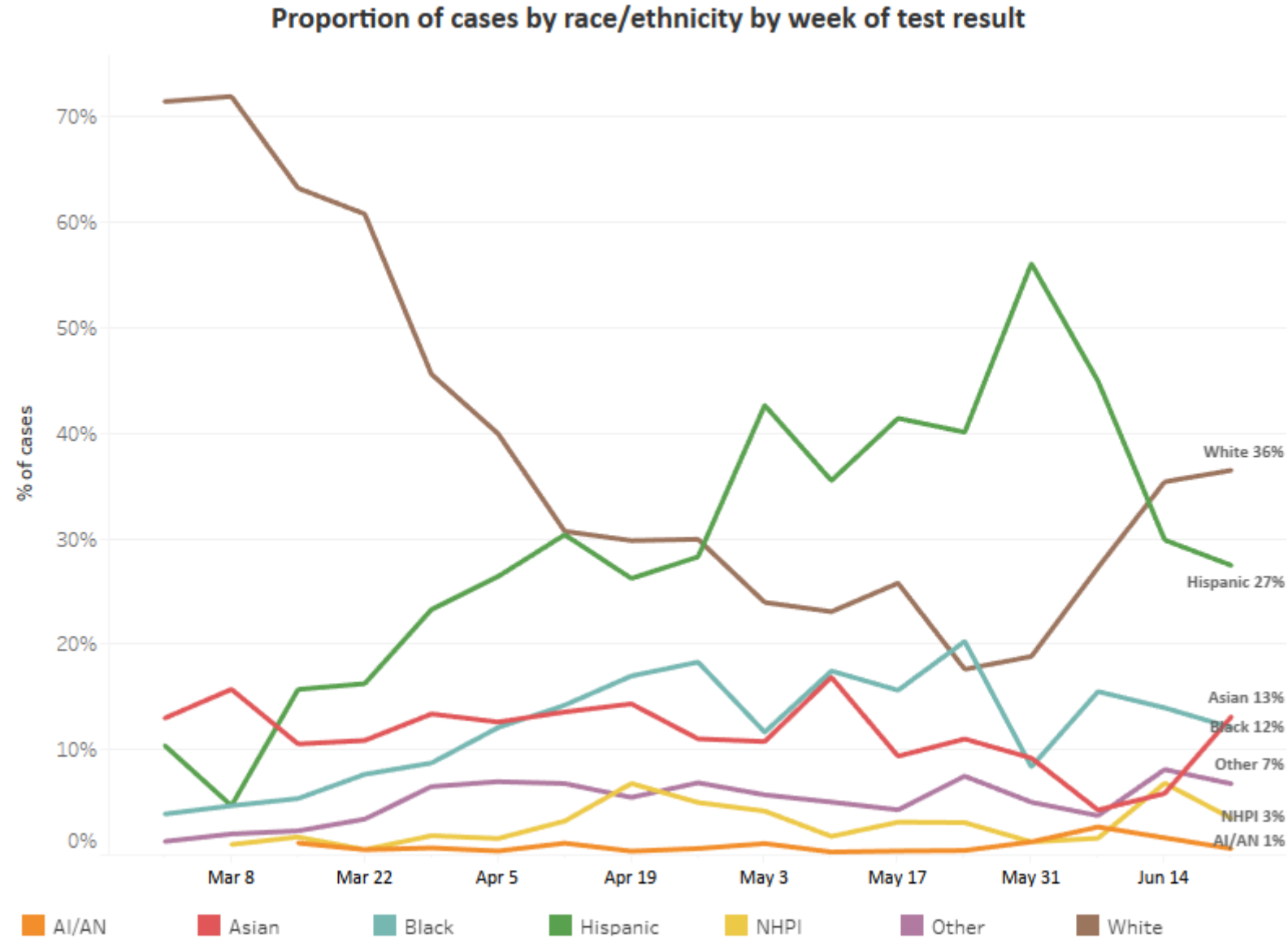

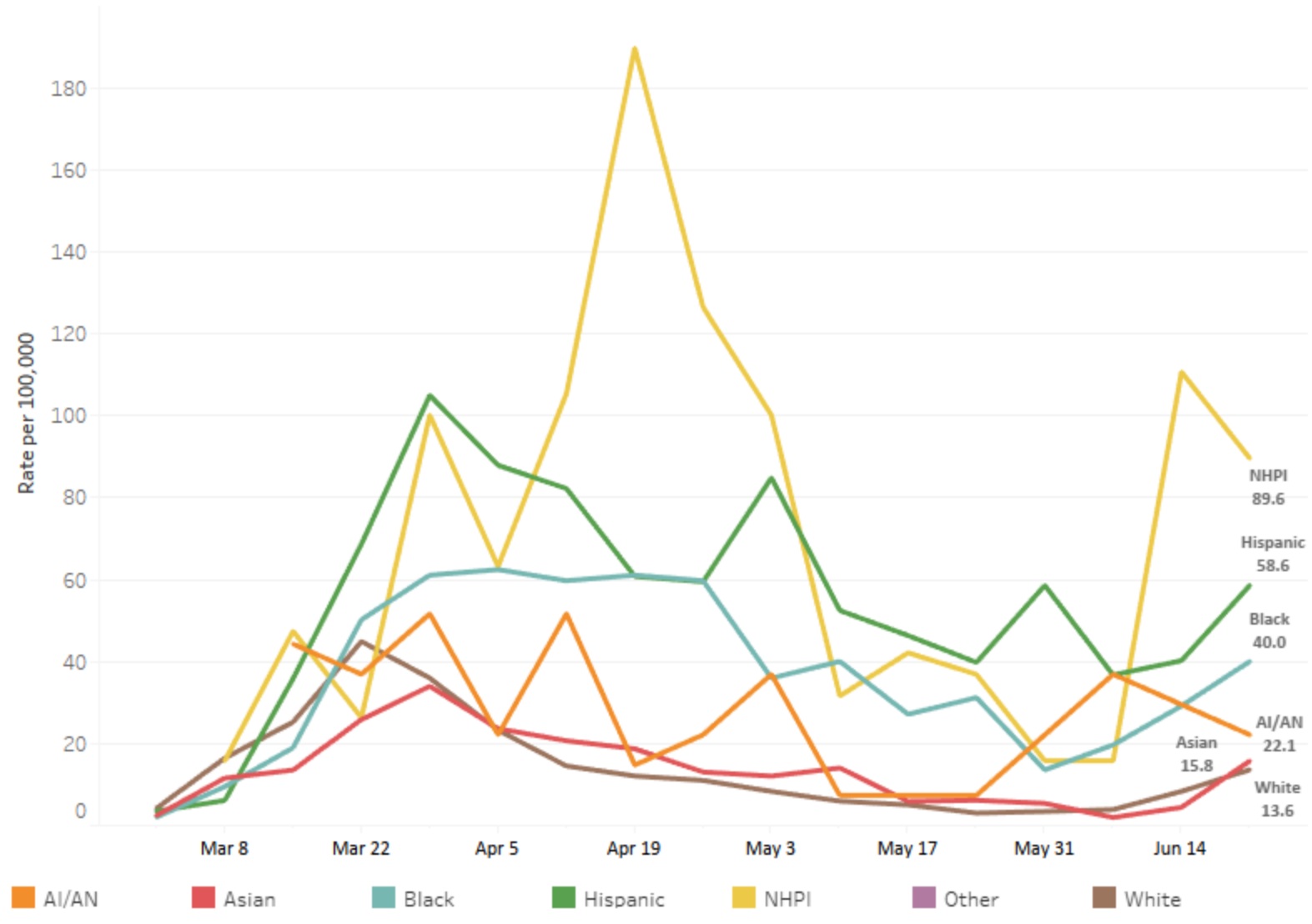
How has the distribution of cases by race/ethnicity changed over time?
